## **Call for Special Sessions**











SPEC 2022 organizing committee welcomes and encourages the proposals for special sessions, which will focus on specific topics within the conference's main themes. Indeed, in addition to the regular sessions, special sessions will help authors submit papers that can cover related topics to the conference under subjects or cross-disciplinary subjects of specific interests of innovation, updated research topics, current novel projects, and new advances in power electronics, etc. Special sessions help participants to meet and discuss specific and updated topics on power electronics.

All interested researchers or academics who would like to propose and organize a special session should send their Special Session proposals to the Chair of the conference at: <a href="mailto:a.kouzou@univ-djelfa.dz">a.kouzou@univ-djelfa.dz</a>.

All proposals must be submitted using the Special Session **TEMPLATE** and include the following information:

- 1. Title of the Special Session. The full names, affiliations, and contact information of all the special session organizers.
- 2. A list of sub-topics related to the proposal (not more than 12 sub-topics)
- 3. A list of potential authors and their affiliations (not less than 10)
- 4. A short abstract describing the covered specific topic in approximately 300 words. This abstract has to be ended with the answer to the question: Why do you believe that this special Session proposal is a significant and interesting subject to be presented in SPEC 2022?



## Special Session Proposal

#### Organization of special sessions

The proposal for the Special Session will be reviewed by the chairs and the decision of approval will be provided to the organizers in less than 5 working days. Once the proposal is accepted and approved, it is the responsibility of the Organizers to disseminate, distribute and publicize their Special Session (SS) among academics, students, researchers, industry, and practitioners interested in the proposed topic of the SS to attract a sufficient number of submissions. The organizers of the Special session should follow strictly the rules of organizing a special session:

- > The special session should contain six (06) accepted papers from at least three different universities/institutes/industries entities, etc. At the same time, the accepted papers should be at least from two countries. Any Special session that fails to collect this number will have its accepted papers moved to the regular session.
- ➤ The registration process is identical to that of regular papers.
- The Special Sessions cannot submit more than two papers that are co-authored by the same author (among the authors of the paper).
- The review process will be the same as that of regular papers and the reviewers should not have any contact or interest with the authors of the paper.
- The organizers' total number of co-authored papers should not exceed 4 of the accepted papers.
- All special session papers are presented as one or more oral sessions where each oral session should not include more than six papers.

#### Important:

- A free registration will be granted to the organizers of a successful Special Session for every 5 papers not co-authored by at least one of the organizers. This free registration can be used by the organizers fully or divided among two or more organizers based on 100% of one free full registration (as an example two organizers can benefit from a 50% discount for each).
- During the conference, the successful special sessions will be chaired by one of the organizers who will attend the conference.
- If the organizer will not be able to attend the conference, the Chairs of the conference will delegate another colleague to chair the mentioned oral sessions.
- The rule of publication of special session papers in the conference proceedings will follow the rules of the regular paper.
